

January 18, 2024

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special meeting at the City Hall Back Conference Room at 1134 F Street. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

COUNCILORS PRESENT: Mayor Johnson; Councilor Forsmann; Councilor Klein; Councilor Liedkie; Councilor Schroeder (3:45 p.m.); Councilor Spickelmire (Zoom).

COUNCILORS EXCUSED: Council President Kleeburg.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. CITIZEN COMMENTS

John Thompson, President of the International Association of FireFighters, said they are excited for negotiations to get started and encouraged the Council to reach out with any questions.

Tim Parker, Vice President and Union Representative of the International Association of FireFighters, said he appreciates the opportunity to collaborate with the City and they have a good working relationship.

IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS

Please note that identifying an item as an “Action Item” does not require the City Council to vote on that item.

- A. COLLECTIVE LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS LOCAL #1773:** Review and discussion about the current Collective Labor Agreement between the City of Lewiston and the International Association of Firefighters Local #1773, which agreement expires on September 30, 2024

Mayor Johnson explained the purpose of the special meeting was to provide discussion and information on the current collective labor agreement not for collective bargaining.

Councilors then reviewed, asked questions, and received clarification on the current Collective Labor Agreement Articles 1 through 15. The remaining articles will be

discussed at the January 29th special meeting.

Councilor Schroeder arrived at 3:45 pm.

Councilor Liedkie excused herself at 3:56 p.m. to take an urgent call.

- B. UNITED AIRLINES MINIMUM REVENUE GUARANTEE** : Discussion and consideration of the request to provide a minimum revenue guarantee to United Airlines for the 2024 fiscal year and providing direction to Mayor Johnson and City staff regarding such request - Action Item

Mayor Johnson explained that at a joint meeting with the Airport Authority Board, Nez Perce County Commissioners and City Council, it was requested that the city provide a minimum revenue guarantee to United Airlines for the 2024 fiscal year.

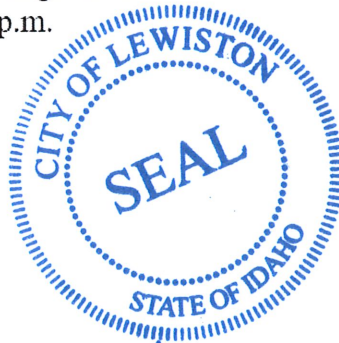
Councilor Liedkie returned to the meeting at 3:59 p.m.

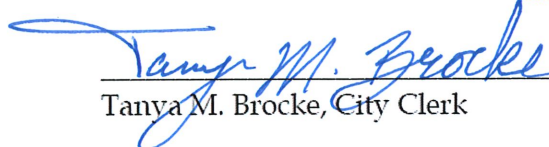
