THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special Meeting at the City Hall Back Conference Room at 1134 F Street. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

- A. COLLECTIVE LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS LOCAL #1773:** Review and discussion about the current Collective Labor Agreement between the City of Lewiston and the International Association of Firefighters Local #1773, which agreement expires on September 30, 2024

Councilors reviewed, asked questions, and received clarification on the current Collective Labor Agreement Articles 15 through 38.

- B. UNITED AIRLINES MINIMUM REVENUE GUARANTEE :** Receiving an update regarding negotiations of a minimum revenue guarantee agreement with United Airlines for the 2024 fiscal year and discussion regarding the same - Action Item

Mayor Johnson informed Councilors that the Legal Department had sent a red-line contract regarding the minimum revenue guarantee to the Lewiston-Nez Perce County Regional Airport and United Airlines for review, but had not received the contract back as of the time of the meeting.

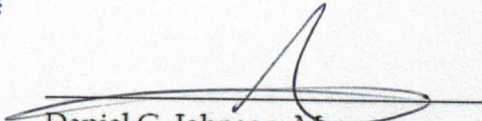
- C. **RESOLUTION 2024-1**: Considering approving the Air Services Agreement between United Airlines, Inc. and the City of Lewiston - Action Item

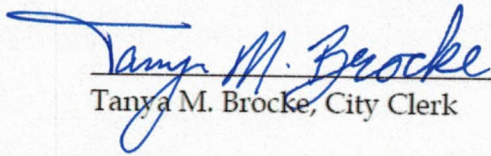
