A. PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT REPORT - JANUARY 2024: A summary from Public Works Director Johnson of the various conditions of the City of Lewiston's pavement - Action Item

Public Works Director Johnson explained the Lewis-Clark Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization funded a pavement assessment to provide a standardized rating for all the City of Lewiston's maintained streets. The draft Pavement Management Report - January 2024 outlines the methodology on how streets were scored, the criteria for how each street classification was scored, and an appendix listing the ratings for all street segments of the transportation system.
