THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special at the Community Center Steelhead Room at 1424 Main Street. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:15 PM.

I. CALL TO ORDER

COUNCILORS PRESENT: Mayor Johnson; Councilor Forsmann; Councilor Klein; Councilor Liedkie; Councilor Schroeder; Councilor Spickelmire.

COUNCILORS EXCUSED: Council President Kleeburg.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. ACTIVE AGENDA

A. IFB-23-020 LEWISTON COMMUNITY CENTER TRANSIT STOP (TR060):

Reconsidering accepting the bid from Kenaston Corporation for the Lewiston Community Center Transit Stop in the amount of \$930,851.00, considering visiting the proposed Transit Stop site, and authorizing the Mayor to execute the contract - Action Item (Transit Manager Seigneur)

Mayor Johnson explained that a special meeting was called for additional information to be provided to the City Council in regard to the Lewiston Community Center Transit Stop.

Transit Manager Seigneur provided a route map and layout of the proposed transit stop, explaining that the Lewiston Community Center is not part of the feasibility study for potential consolidation of city services. Additionally, establishing a transit hub would provide a safer environment for citizens at the Community Center, and if the project is not completed, the City would have to repay funding to the federal government.

Councilors Liedkie and Forsmann moved and seconded, respectively, for the Council to visit the proposed Transit Stop site and to return to the meeting for further discussion. The motion carried 5-0 and the Council visited the site at 3:23 p.m.

After visiting the proposed Transit Stop site, Mayor Johnson resumed the Special City Council meeting at 3:33 p.m.

Councilors Liedkie and Schroeder moved and seconded, respectively, to award IFB-23-020 to Kenaston Corporation and to authorize the Mayor to execute the contract between the City of Lewiston and Kenaston Corporation. **ROLL CALL VOTE: VOTING AYE: Klein; Forsmann; Schroeder; Liedkie. VOTING NAY: Spickelmire. EXCUSED: Kleeburg.**

IV. UNFINISHED AND NEW BUSINESS

- A. CITY COUNCILOR COMMENTS:** Comments shall not be related to an item currently before the City Council or an item that may come before the City Council in the foreseeable future, and shall be limited to comments, not discussion.

Councilor Schroeder apologized for not being in attendance at the June 10, 2024 Regular Meeting.

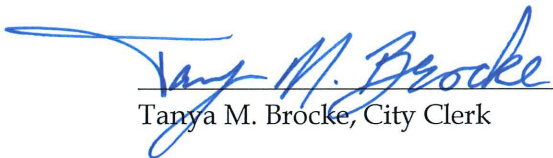
B. MAYOR COMMENTS
