THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special Meeting Budget Session #5 in the Bell Building Second Floor Conference Room at 215 D Street. As both Mayor Johnson and Council President Kleeburg were excused, City Attorney Tengono called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

COUNCILORS PRESENT: Schroeder; Forsmann; Spickelmire; Klein; Liedkie (3:02 p.m.).

COUNCILORS EXCUSED: Mayor Johnson; Council President Kleeburg.

Councilors Forsmann and Spickelmire moved and seconded, respectively, to appoint Councilor Schroeder as the Acting Chair for the meeting. **ROLL CALL: VOTING AYE: Klein; Spickelmire; Forsmann; Schroeder. VOTING NAY: None. EXCUSED: Kleeburg; Liedkie.**

Councilor Liedkie arrived at 3:02 p.m.

IV. BUDGET REVIEW

Councilor Liedkie noted she attended the AIC Annual Conference and mentioned that they have informative material on budgeting that the Councilors could review.

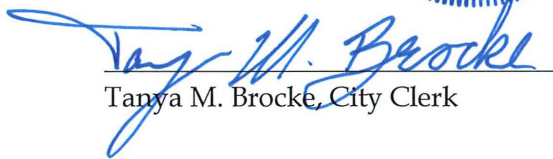
B. MAYOR COMMENTS

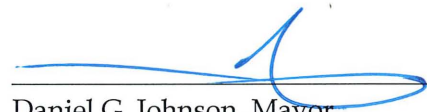
