The Lewiston Comprehensive Plan Work Plan Development Committee met in the Bell Building First Floor Conference Room at 215 “D” Street. City Planner, Joel Plaskon called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

IV. REVIEW OF AND DISCUSSION ABOUT ENVISION LEWISTON 2024 PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS; CHAPTER 11, IMPLEMENTATION; AND APPENDIX A, ACTION PLAN

Planner Plaskon reviewed the purpose of the committee and then provided a summary of the highlights from the public engagement. Planner Plaskon reviewed the high priority items from the Action Plan and encouraged the committee to pay attention to the timelines associated with each of the high priority items.

The committee then discussed a number of the high priority items and what each of them viewed as important. The committee agreed that Public Services, Facilities, and Utilities; Land Use; and Housing were top priorities to them.

The committee discussed the action items in the three (3) categories they wanted to concentrate on and decided to review the items in the Land Use category first.
