THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special Meeting in the City Hall Back Conference Room at 1134 F Street. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM.

I. CALL TO ORDER

COUNCILORS PRESENT: Mayor Johnson; Council President Kleeburg; Councilor Forsmann (2:33 p.m.); Councilor Klein (Zoom); Councilor Schroeder; Councilor Spickelmire; Councilor Wright.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. ACTION ITEMS

- A. RESOLUTION 2025-30:** Considering consenting to the continuance of the June 12, 2025 Declaration of Local disaster Emergency pertaining to the May 31, 2025 Hatwai Fire beyond seven (7) days of its inception, in accordance with Idaho Code § 46-1011 - Action Item

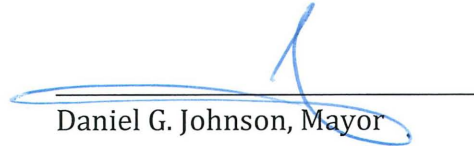
Mayor Johnson explained that a Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency was issued on June 12, 2025, in response to the May 31, 2025 Hatwai Fire. Initially, a declaration was not issued due to uncertainty about whether the fire occurred within city limits. The Fire Chief indicated it would depend on the exact boundary line, and the City Surveyor later confirmed that a small portion of the fire area falls within city limits, though no structures were affected. Once confirmed, the declaration was issued. Since declarations are only valid for seven days, Council consideration to extend the declaration is necessary to maintain eligibility for any potential reimbursement from the State of Idaho or a third party.

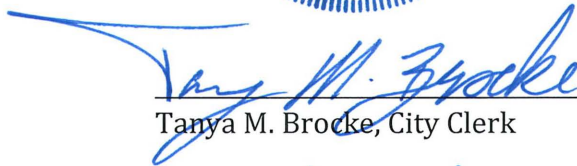
