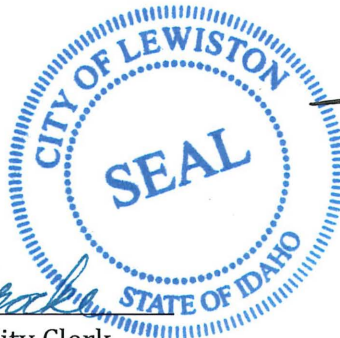

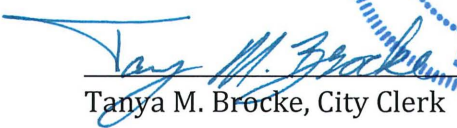
Councilors Forsmann and Schroeder moved to exit the executive session at 3:57 p.m. The motion passed 6-0.
