THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISTON, IDAHO, met in a Special Meeting at the Lewiston City Hall Back Conference Room at 1134 F Street. Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

II. ACTION ITEMS

- A. RESOLUTION 2023-31:** Considering consent to the continuance of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency from the June 9, 2023, flooding beyond seven (7) days of its inception, in accordance with Idaho Code Section 46-1011 - Action Item

Council President Liedkie asked for clarification on the extension. Emergency Management Director Mark Hurd explained the extension will allow them time to get the information and assessment of damages to the Idaho Office of Emergency Management (IOEM) before the Local Disaster Emergency Declaration goes to the Governor's Office for signature.
